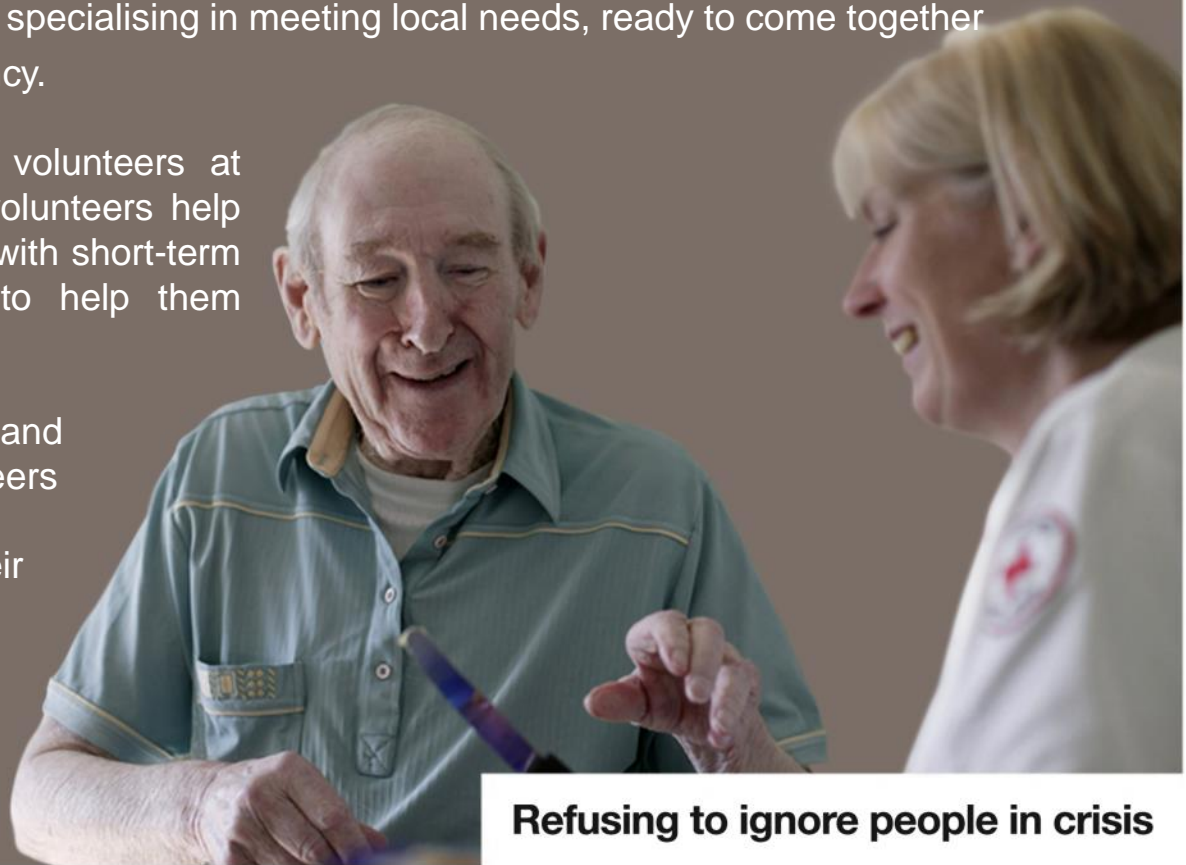
Supporting the British Red Cross
